

PACS Project – Trainer Training Programme in Varna

April 20–25, 2026 – Our school, Miskolc SZC Kandó Kálmán Technical School of IT, participated in the trainer training course of the Erasmus+ project titled ***Professionals in Action for Crisis Situations (PACS)*** organized by the Bulgarian Nikola Vaptsarov Naval Academy in Varna.

During the program, the project partners – CSEA from Romania, NVNA from Bulgaria, and our school – worked together on further developing the professional content of the project. The objectives of the meeting were to learn about the practical implementation of the curriculum plan developed so far, expand professional knowledge, jointly evaluate the project's results achieved to date, and plan the next steps.

Main Topics of the Meeting:

During the six-day program, we:

- explored the training infrastructure and technological capabilities of NVNA, including simulators, equipment for water rescue exercises, and drone technology solutions;
- coordinated communication and dissemination activities;
- reviewed financial management rules and documentation requirements;
- worked jointly on the professional content of **WP2 – Integrated Crisis Management Course** and **WP3 – Guide of Good Practices**;
- updated project management documents and the timeline.

The partners agreed on the tasks for the upcoming period, with special focus on finalizing the learning materials, developing the methodological guide, and preparing for the next phase of the project.
